This clothing list should be used as a guideline for packing. Suggested quantities are based on needs for one week at camp. Use your discretion when packing and keep in mind that there are no laundry facilities for campers. Please use duffle or hockey bags to pack your belongings (available at sporting goods or army surplus type stores). Trunks and suitcases are too difficult to store, are very cumbersome and therefore not recommended for camp. Please attach an identification tag (enclosed) to your duffel bag and clearly label with student name and the name of the school.
