CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT LIST

(Use this as a checklist before leaving home)

This clothing list should be used as a guideline for packing. Suggested quantities are based on needs for one week at camp. Use your discretion when packing and keep in mind that there are no laundry facilities for campers. Please use duffel or hockey bags to pack your belongings (available at sporting goods or army surplus type stores). Trunks and suitcases are too difficult to store, are very cumbersome and therefore not recommended for camp. **Please attach an identification tag (provided by teacher) to your duffel bag and clearly label with student name and the name of the school.**

ESSENTIAL ITEMS

- Bathing suit
- Boots for wet weather (rubber or hiking)
- Hat
- Jacket
- Jeans
- Laundry bag or plastic bag (for dirty clothes)
- Pyjamas - warm
- Raincoat
- Running shoes
- Water shoes for waterfront activities
- Shorts - 3 pairs
- Socks for 8 days
- Sweater or sweatshirt - 2
- T-shirts or jerseys - 5
- Underwear for 8 days
- Water Bottle/Canteen
- Money for Tuck Goodies (\$25 is suggested)

PROGRAM EQUIPMENT

- Instrument (labelled) *n/a for vocal
- Folding music stand (with name on both parts)
- Pencil
- Clothes pins (4) to hold music on stand
- Kleenex

TOILETRY ITEMS

- Towels/Face Cloths
- Comb or brush
- Toothbrush
- Toothpaste
- Soap with container
- Shampoo/Conditioner
- Insect repellent
- Sun screen (minimum SPF 15)
- Hand sanitizer

BEDDING

- Sleeping bag
 - Sheet for underneath
 - Pillow
- OR
- Heavy Wool Blankets - 2
 - Sheets - 2
 - Pillow

OPTIONAL ITEMS

- Camera
- Sun glasses
- Flashlight

We suggest that all articles being brought to Camp be **labelled** with the camper's first and last name for easy identification. Use cloth or masking tape for toiletry, program equipment, and optional items, and please use a marker or name tags for clothing.

Any money (or other valuables) brought to camp should be kept in our office "bank", which is accessible during rec periods.

****Important Note:** *Weather at camp can be unpredictable and temperatures can be warm and/or cold. Please pack a variety of clothing as outlined above.*
